Among these, there are both private vacation homes and rental properties available for travelers who seek true privacy. The guest experience is managed and overseen by Elite Havens.



The design team, A49HD, drew inspiration from the atmosphere of the Andaman coastline and blended it with a contemporary style, keeping in mind the balance of space between indoor and outdoor areas. The spacious balcony opens up to the surrounding scenery, which includes beautifully landscaped gardens, creating a serene and pleasant view. Start your day early, as this location is conveniently close to Natai Bridge, which extends into the sea. Beneath the bridge, you'll find a thriving fishing area, making it a favorite spot for anglers. If you're in search of fresh seafood, visiting in the morning is highly recommended.

Alternatively, immerse yourself in the local culture by visiting the nearby Natai Morning Market. Here, you'll find a range of fresh produce, local ingredients, ready-to-eat meals, and traditional clothing. However, the market is open only on Sundays from 5:00 AM to 10:00 AM.



Not only its tranquility, but the way of life and community bonding are also key charms of this place. For example, a short one-day trip allows you to visit places like Phu Taan or the community enterprise formed by local women of Kokkloy Village. They have turned the abundant tal tree resources in the area into various products, including woodwork, tie-dye fabrics, and candle-printed textiles. You can stop by to support them or even showcase your skills in a workshop class. Then, head to nearby Thai Mueang District for activities such as kayaking through the mangrove forests at Ban Tha Din Daeng Community, where you can immerse yourself in the beautiful nature of Khao Lampi - Hat Thai Mueang National Park.





You can also visit sacred sites like Wat Tha Sai or Wat Thep Thammanava, a teakwood temple featuring an ordination hall that houses a Buddha statue in the First Sermon posture, intricately carved from white jade in an Indian artistic style. Wat Tha Sai is distinguished by its ordination hall, built entirely of teakwood, surrounded by lush trees, and situated right by the sea—just a step across the road. On the other side of the temple, there's another perfect spot for travelers to pause and enjoy the sea breeze, with views that rival any beach. As you can see, Phang Nga offers much more than just a relaxing getaway or diving adventures—it's full of hidden gems waiting to be discovered.
