Ukiyo Chalet

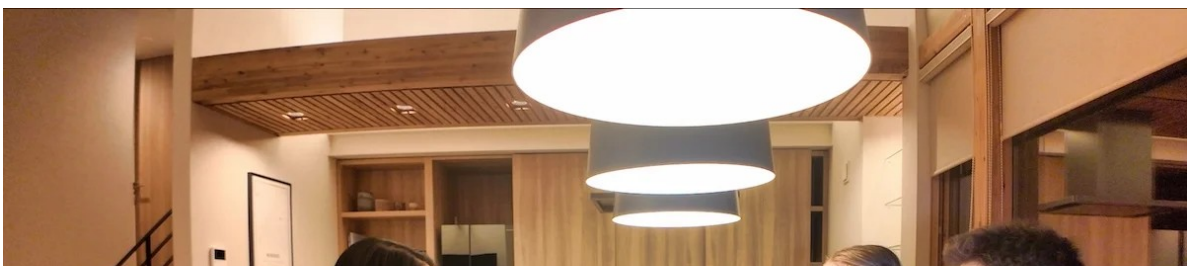
